- ** There is no authority to arrest a person for a minor misdemeanor traffic violation unless both of the following apply:
 - 1. The person is issued a citation for an offense prohibited by Chapter 4511., 4513., or 4549. of the Revised Code or an act prohibited by the Revised Ordinances of Chillicothe that is substantially similar to any section contained in Chapter 4511., 4513., or 4549. of the Revised Code, and
 - 2. A. The person is an Ohio resident but does not have a current valid Ohio driver's or commercial driver's license, or
 - B. The person is a resident of another state that is not a member of the nonresident violator compact of which Ohio is a member pursuant to section 4510.71 of the Revised Code.

In that case, the law enforcement officer may require the person to post reasonable security in the amount of \$150.00. The \$150.00 may be paid in cash, check, or credit card, and the officer shall give the person a receipt. If paying by credit card, the person may be asked to accompany the officer to the Ross County Law Enforcement Complex where the credit card transaction may take place. The person shall be released as soon as possible after completing the credit card transaction. (R.C. 2935.27)

* If the charge is an "Offense of Violence" listed below or a violation of R.C. 2919.27, then the bail schedule is as follows:

** If the charge is an offense of violence involving a family or household member, then the defendant must appear before the court for the setting of bail if any of the following applies:

- The defendant is subject to the terms of a protection order;
- 2. The defendant was previously convicted of a violation of any of the following:
 - a. domestic violence (2919.25),
 - b. violating a protection order (2919.27),
 - c. criminal damaging or endangering (2909.06) where the victim was a family or household member,
 - d. criminal mischief (2909.07) where the victim was a family or household member,
 - e. burglary (2911.12) where the victim was a family or household member,
 - f. aggravated trespass (2911.211) where the victim was a family or household member,
 - g. any offense of violence where the victim was a family or household member; or
- 3. The arresting officer indicates any of the following:
 - a. he observed objective manifestations of physical harm, or
 - b. he believes defendant had a deadly weapon or dangerous ordnance, or
 - c. he reasonably believes that defendant presents a credible threat of serious physical harm.

Selected Ohio Department of Natural Resources Cases

For the offenses listed in the attached Schedules, the bond amount is fixed as shown on the Schedules, as they may be amended from time to time.

Felony Cases

In a case involving a felony, the judge shall fix the amount of bail. (R.C. 2937.23)

Pursuant to the authority of Rule 46 of the Ohio Criminal Rules, Rule III (5) of the Local Rules of the Local Rules of the Chillicothe Municipal Court, and Sections 2919.251, 2935.15, and 2937.23 of the Ohio Revised Code, the above amounts and formulas are hereby established and published. The posting of bail or the deposit of security is for the purpose of securing appearance only. The forfeiture of the bail or security is not a substitute for appearance in Court and payment of penalty imposed on a plea and finding of guilty. Bail shall be in a form authorized by Ohio Criminal Rule 46. In addition to the amount of bail, the amounts required by R.C. 2743.70 and R.C. 2949.091 shall be added to the bail and held by the clerk of the court as set forth in those sections.

SPECIAL NOTICE

The attention of all law enforcement officers and personnel is called to the provisions of Ohio Criminal Rule 46 relating to bail, and also to the provisions of Section 2935.26 of the Ohio Revised Code, providing for the issuance of citations in lieu of arrest on minor misdemeanor cases, except in certain instances.

Any former schedules of bail in conflict with this schedule are hereby repealed and superseded by this schedule.
